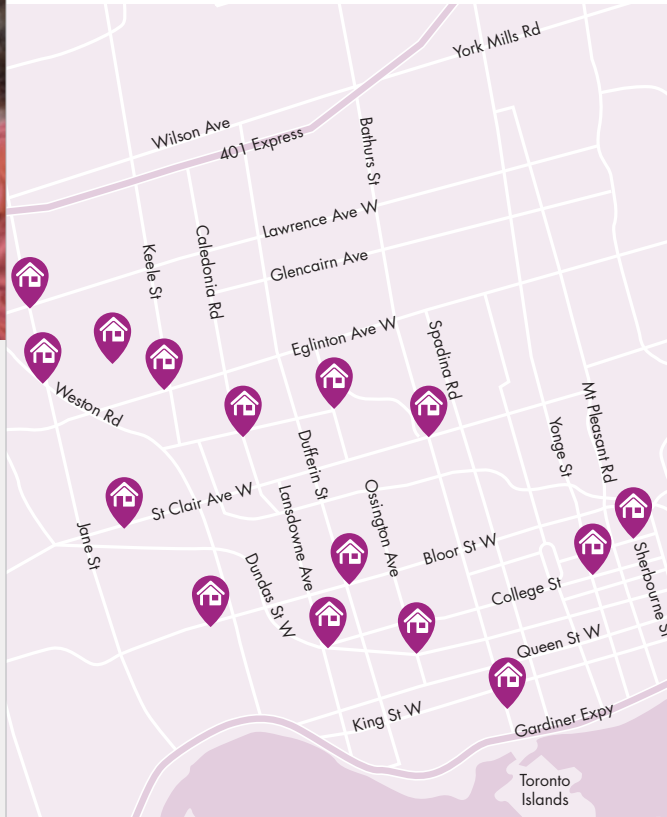




Locations

Network's Home Child Care programs consider each child's particular needs and abilities. Our Providers plan activities based on observations and child interests, and use Ministry of Education guidelines to deliver stimulating and supportive care.

Our providers

Network's experienced and knowledgeable Providers offer personalized, nurturing care for mixed-age groups, in their own homes. All adult residents in the home undergo security and health screenings and Providers must complete specialized child care training on a regular basis.

Learning environment

In-home care offers an emotionally secure environment where each child feels safe, valued and respected. Network Providers follow all Provincial and Municipal environment standards for licensed Home Child Care spaces, and work to exceed quality care standards at all times.

How to choose quality Home Child Care

Questions families should ask when looking for care:

- Do I want child care close to home or work?
- Do the Provider's hours fit my schedule?
- Do I need full-time or part-time care?
- Do I need care for more than one child?
- Would I feel comfortable leaving my child there?
- Do I need help with the cost of child care?

Compare Your Choices

Always visit a Provider's home before enrolling a child. Here are some helpful questions:

- Is the Home Child Care space licensed?
- Are children being guided in appropriate ways?
- Do children seem to feel included and engaged in the program?
- Is the physical space safe, clean and inviting?
- Are posted activities and materials right for a child's age and development?
- Can children choose their own activities?
- Are there a variety of nutritious meals and snacks on the posted menu?
- Does the Provider participate in continuing education?
