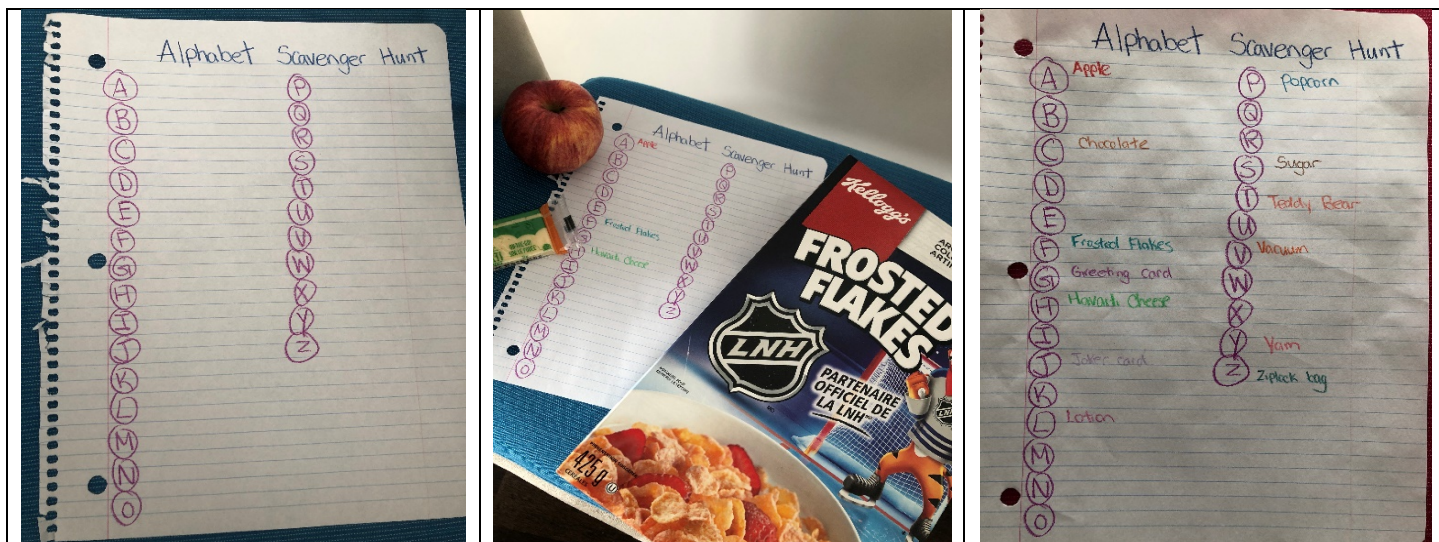


Title: Alphabet Scavenger Hunt

Age Group: Kindergarten/ School Age

Type of Activity: Game with Rules

Materials:

- A blank piece of paper
- Pen/Pencil
- Items around your household

How to Do it:

- Write out the letters from A-Z on a blank piece of paper
- Ask your child to look for as many items around the house as he/she can find beginning with each letter of the alphabet
- Challenge your child to write down what they found on the list

Root Skill / Extension:

Cognitive: 4.2 Problem-Solving / Literacy: 3.7 Writing

Extend the learning: Add colours and numbers to the scavenger hunt. You can also increase the level of complexity by using clues such as: 'I rain on you when it's time to scrub, I'm very close to the tub'; using a timer, or (if you have a large family) creating teams, i.e. Parents vs Kids.
