

# Title: Animal Lift-a-flap Board

Age Group: Infant

Type of Activity: Cognitive

## Materials:

- Cardboard or large Bristol board
- Pictures of animals and their skin prints
- Markers (if you want to decorate)
- Glue
- Scissors (if you need to cut)
- You can choose any theme you would like

## How to Do it:

- Cover the cardboard with paper or paint if you have
- Paste the pictures of the animals on the cardboard, write the animal names on the pictures
- To make the flap, fold a little bit at the top and glue the folded part on the cardboard.
- On the outside of the flap, paste the print that goes with the animal

## Root Skill / Extension:

### **Cognitive 4.7: representation and 4.8: memory**

Extend the learning: Can your child guess which animal is underneath the flap before they lift it? You can also mimic the sounds of the animals and practice repetition with your child.
