

Title: Farm Felt Board

Age Group: Infant

Type of Activity: Communication and Language

Materials:

- Cardboard box (you can use an empty cereal box for the felt board base)
- Felt sheet (large enough to cover the cardboard box). Use an old flannel sheet if you don't have a large enough piece of craft felt for this
- Animal pictures (see attached for pictures you can colour or trace)
- Scissors
- Glue

How to Do it:

- Cut the cereal box to create a flat square or rectangle base.
- Spread glue on the cardboard and wrap/cover it with a felt sheet.
- Colour & cut animal pictures using the printout provided below.
- Glue felt backings to each cut-out.
- Once all pieces are complete, your children can help put the felt on the board as you label images, sing songs, or read stories.

Root Skill / Extension:

This activity assists in building receptive language and communication skills through the process of hearing and repeating sounds and naming animals.

Extend this activity by: Adding different animals to hear different tones and sounds for each animal. You can use this felt board for many different stories by adding new cut-outs. Enjoy!
