## Materials:

## How to Do it:

- From your balcony, window, backyard or while walking outside, look at trees, plants and nature around you.
  - See what shapes, letters or numbers you can see that are naturally occurring
  - Talk about what you see with your child
- (Please remember to keep physical distancing during activities)

## Root Skill / Extension:

This builds number and letter recognition with your child and enhances their observational skills. Take pictures and write down the name of the shape, letter or number that you saw. Have your child try to draw the shape, or find the shape inside the house (coffee table, poster etc.)
