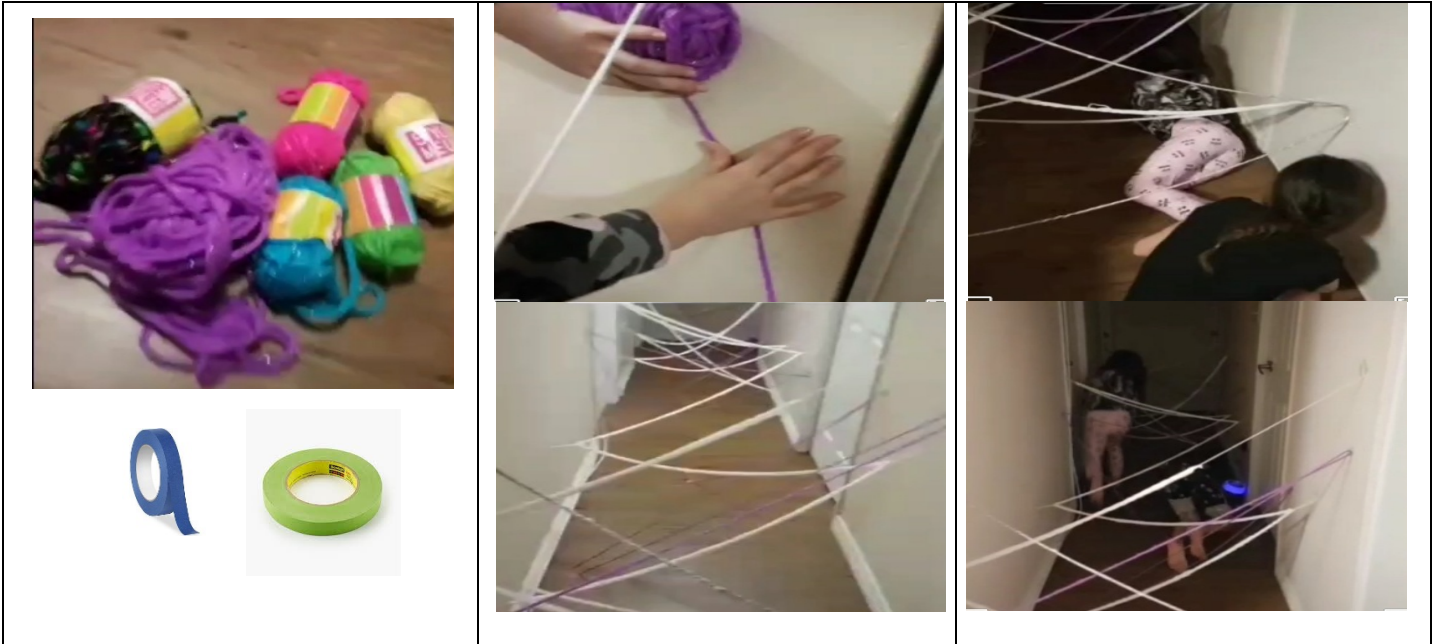


# Title: Laser String Maze

Age Group: Preschool / School age

Type of Activity: Physical Gross Motor & Cognitive

## Materials:

- Yarn (any colour works)
- Tape
- Hallway (as an alternative you can connect 6 chairs to create a hallway space)

## How to Do it:

- Have your child help create the maze.
- Start by taping one end of the yarn ball to the wall (or chair)
- As your child holds the yarn ball, move from wall to wall taping a small portion of the yarn to each wall in a zig zag motion. You will not need to cut any yarn; the yarn can be one continuous strand.
- Your child can be as creative as they wish and re-create the maze in many ways.

## Root Skill / Extension:

**Physical Gross Motor 5. 1: Balancing and climbing skill**

**Cognitive 4.2: Problem solving skills**

This activity will provide your child with a physical movement activity and encourages problem solving as they maneuver through the maze.

**Extend the learning:** Turn the light out and provide a flashlight or lamp to make the maze more difficult and exciting for your children. Enjoy!
