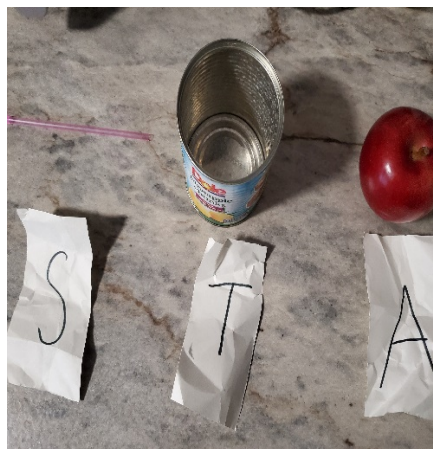


# Title: Lets Clean Up

Age Group: Preschoolers

Type of Activity: Cognitive/Physical/Language and Literacy

## Materials:

- Markers, pencil crayons or crayons
- Paper
- Scissors
- 3 bowls
- Random materials around the house

## How to Do it:

- Write letters A-Z on separate pieces of paper.
- Without your child seeing, scrunch up the paper like “garbage” and place them around your house.
- Let your child find the “garbage” and see what the letter is.
- Your child (with your help) can find things around the house that starts with the letter, A for Apple or T for Tin can.
- When you have found an item with the letter found, try to see where the item belongs. (Green bin, Black bin, or Recyclables)

## Root Skill / Extension:

**Communication, language and literacy 3.11: Letter Recognition** (identifying the letters)

**And 3.10: Phonological Awareness:** (identifying sounds in their environment)

**Extending the learning:** Separate items to determine which are trash and recycling. Talk with your child about how recycling helps the environment.
