

# Title: Making Binoculars

Age Group: Preschool / Kindergarten

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Type of Activity: Cognitive / Problem Solving

## Materials:

- Cardboard box, square or rectangular
- A paper towel roll
- Scissors
- Glue or tapes (optional)
- Paint / markers / stickers (optional)

## How to Do it:

- Have the children help you to cut the paper towel roll in half.
- Ask the children to trace the size of paper towel onto the cardboard box.
- Let the children cut out holes.
- Insert the paper towel rolls to the holes, and glue or tape them down, if necessary.
- Decorate it with markers, paint or stickers (optional).
- The children can use the binoculars to observe any things that they are interested in, especially outdoors (remember to practice physical distancing when using it outdoors).

## Root Skill / Extension:

### Cognitive 4.2: Problem Solving & 4.19 Measuring

Extend the learning: The parents / caregivers can provide the children a clipboard, the paper and a pencil, then ask them to write down what they see with their binoculars.
