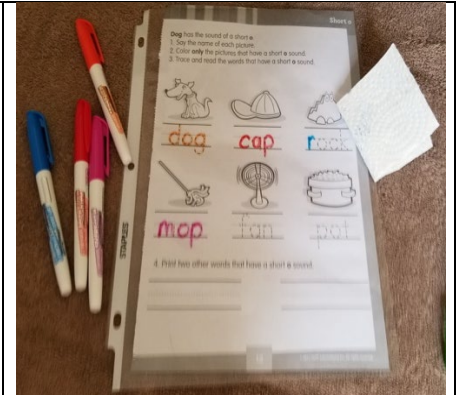
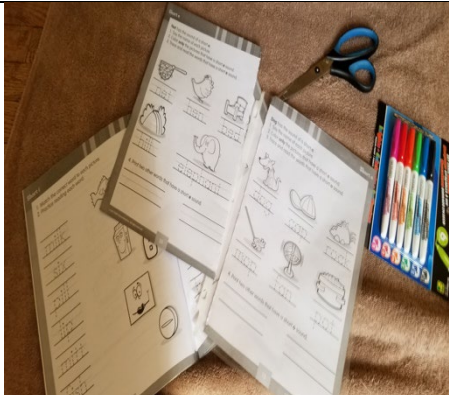
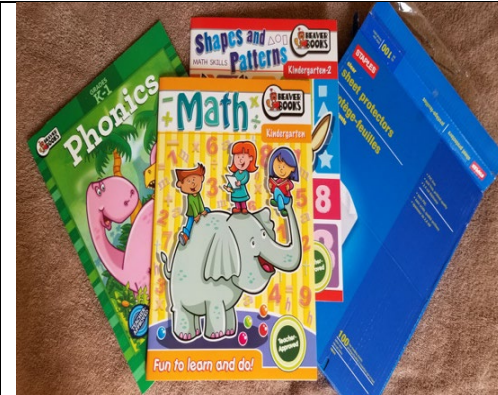


# Title: Making Reusable Workbooks

Type of Activity: Cognitive and Fine Motor

## Materials:

- Activity or workbooks for School Age children
- Plastic sheet covers
- Dry Erase markers
- Paper towel (to wipe marker from the plastic sheet cover)
- Scissors
- Optional: binder or storage box to sort or store worksheets

## How to Do it:

- Remove activity sheets from booklet
- Place individual activity sheets in a plastic sheet cover
- Use dry erase markers to fill in worksheet information
- Wipe off dry erase marker from plastic sheet when finished the page
- Place worksheet back into binder or storage box

## Root Skill / Extension:

This cognitive activity can support math, science, number, vocabulary and reading skills.

Extend the learning: To challenge your child's problem-solving skills, draw a pattern with dots and number them. Ask you child to follow the numbers in order, to discover the picture.
