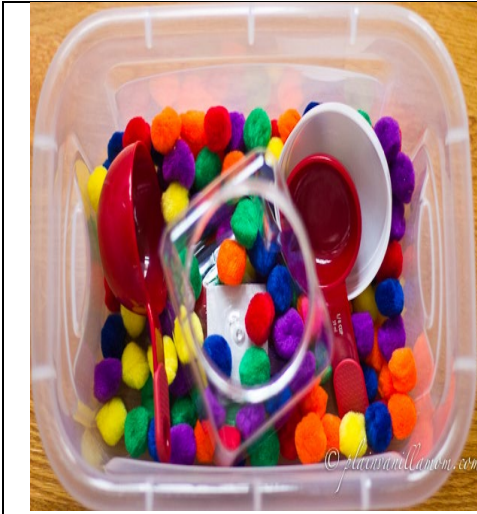


# Title: Pompom Scoop

Age Group: Infant / Toddler

Type of Activity: Fine Motor / Problem Solving

## Materials:

- Assorted pompoms (not appropriate for under 12 months – choking hazard)
- Measuring cups or scoops
- Large bin or bucket

## How to Do it:

- Give your child the container of pompoms, the scoops, and the large container
- Let your child explore dumping and refilling the scoops and containers.

## Root Skill / Extension:

Physical Fine Motor: 5.2 Holding and using tools

In this activity, children will improve their grasping and tool use skills, and practice hand-eye coordination.

Extend the learning: Give your child a regular-sized spoon and different cups so they can sort the various colours. You can name the colours and build their vocabulary
