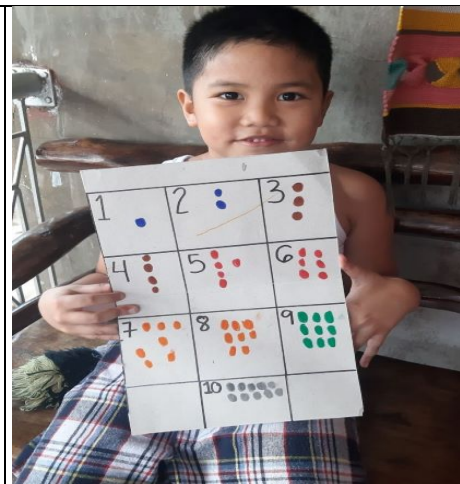


# Title: Simple Counting Activity

Age Group: Preschool

Type of Activity: Math / Numeracy

## Materials:

- Construction Paper/Bristol board
- Washable Markers, crayons
- Pencil, eraser, ruler and scissors (optional)

## How to Do it:

Draw boxes on the construction paper/Bristol board. Number each box and make sure there's enough space for your child to draw inside the box.

Then ask your child to draw how many dots are needed to be in each box.

## Root Skill / Extension:

In this activity children will be able to learn how to count and be able to match numbers and quantities.

You can also use rocks, seeds, or cheerios instead of drawing dots.

To extend this activity, you can add numbers 11 - 20, or have the child create two small cards for each number to make a match-game set.
