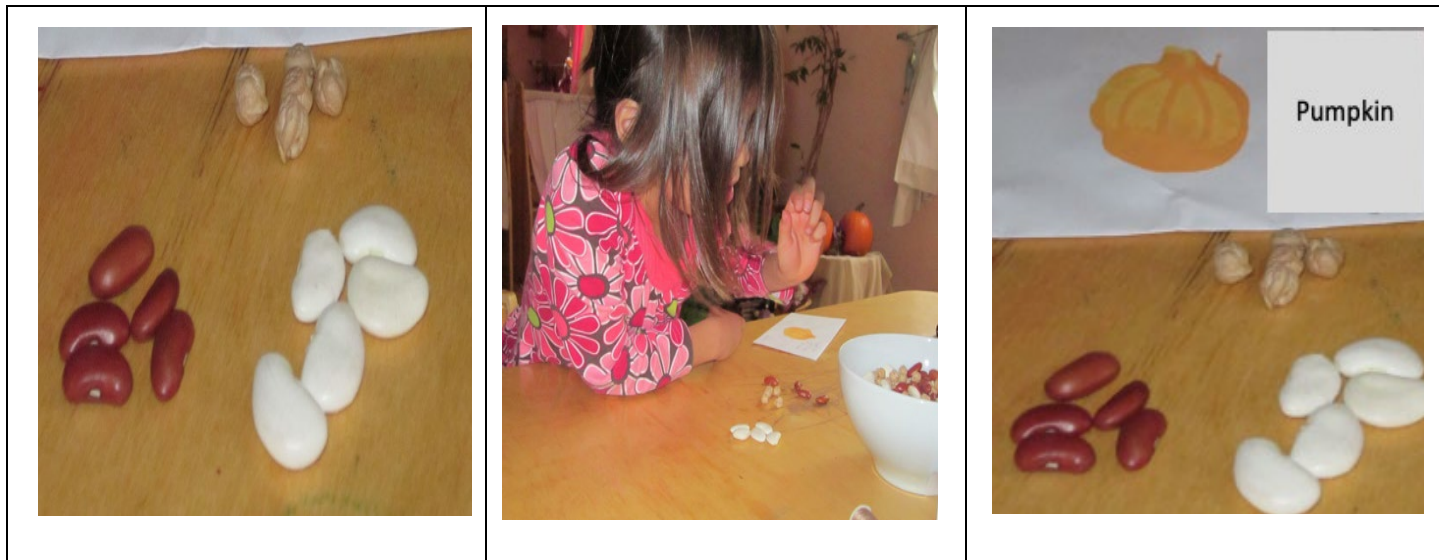


# Title: Sorting Seeds

Age Group: Preschool / School Age

Type of Activity: Cognitive – Sorting

## Materials:

- Common seeds found in the home (kidney, chick pea, beans, peas)
- Bowl
- Paper
- Markers or paint (create a place card with name of the seed or a picture of the corresponding seed)

## How to Do it:

- Put the seeds into a bowl all mixed together
- Have child sort by: size, shape, colour and texture
- Place seed on image, sorting by: size, shape, colour, texture and type

## Root Skill / Extension:

**Cognitive 4.10: Classifying** - Comparing, matching and sorting according to common properties

**Extending the learning:** Create place cards with written numbers and count the seeds. Plant using a paper towel and a zip-lock bag
