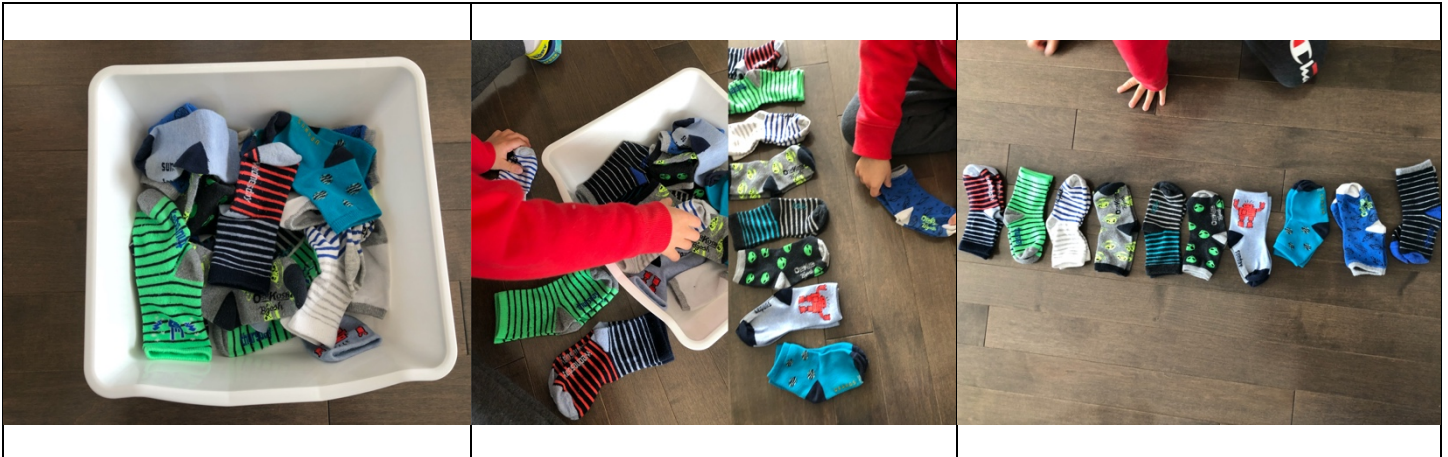


Title: Sorting Socks

Age Group: Infant

Type of Activity: Sorting /Matching Game

Materials:

- Children's socks
- Bin / Box

How to Do it:

- For younger children, line up one of each pair of socks on the floor.
- Put the rest of the socks in the bin.
- Ask your child to find the sock in the bin to match each sock on the floor by putting them into pairs.
- For older children, put all pairs of socks inside the bin and let the children sort them.

Root Skill / Extension:

Cognitive 4.9: Sorting / Physical 5.2: Fine motor

This activity will help children improve their sorting skill (an important math concept) by putting socks into pairs. It will also support children's fine motor grasping skills.

Extend the learning: try sorting games with different objects. For example, sort Lego blocks by colors.
