

Title: Sticky Art

Age Group: Infant

Type of Activity: Sensory

Materials:

- Laminate sheet or clear shelf paper
- Yarn, tissue paper, newspaper, cotton balls, cupcake wrappers
- Tape

How to Do it:

- Prepare a basket with yarn, tissue paper, newspaper, cotton balls, cupcake wrappers, and anything else you want your baby to explore.
- Tape the laminate sheet on the floor (sticky surface face up)
- Let the children experience the stickiness!

Root Skill / Extension:

This activity will encourage exploration and develop a child's hand-eye coordination.

Extend the learning: The parents/caregivers can observe and engage in learning experiences with children and can extend vocabulary by saying the word when a child touches an object.

Open questions: "Why is the floor sticky?" "What will happen when we put the yarn on?"
