

# Title: Sticky Ball

Age Group: Infants

Type of Activity: Fine Motor / Problem Solving

## Materials:

- Small soft ball, with firm outer surface
- Masking tape

## How to Do it:

- Wrap the ball with masking tape until completely covered (Sticky side up!).
- The child will explore the sticky sensation of the ball and / or try to figure out how to remove it from their hands.

## Root Skill / Extension:

Cognitive: Problem-solving / Fine Motor: Tactile Exploration

Extend the learning: You can add some items to the ball so they can try to remove them (and stick them on again). You can also practice vocabulary by identifying body parts by saying, "Can you stick the ball on your head? Can you stick it on your hand? Can you stick it on your leg? Can you stick it on your nose?"
