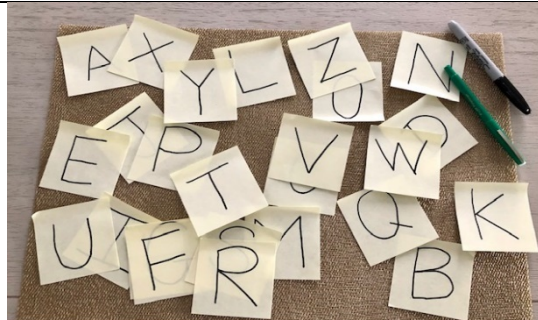


Title: Sticky Note Wall Bop

Age Group: Preschool - Kindergarten

Type of Activity: Cognitive - Rules and Game Play

Materials:

- Sticky notes
- Pen or markers
- A soft ball, a pair of rolled up socks, stuffed animals or bean bags
- Paint Tape

How to Do it:

- Use a pen/marker to write 26 letters on the sticky notes.
- Attach each sticky note to a door (in random order).
- Make a "start" line with the tape a few feet away from the door (more if you have older kids).
- Have your child(ren) stand behind the line with a soft ball/stuffed animals/a pair of rolled up socks/bean bags.
- Now instruct the child(ren) to throw their objects to try and hit the sticky notes.
- Give your child(ren) 10 throws, for each target they hit, mark down the number of points. At the end of the round, tally up to declare a winner.

Root Skill / Extension:

Cognitive 4.11 Games with rules / Physical 5.1 Throwing

- Refer to continuum of Development from ELECT Document (Fish Bone Diagram)

This activity gives the child(ren) an opportunity to participate/lead the learning experiences. It enhances positive interactions between parent and children to support their relationship. You can extend the activity by having your child(ren) hit the letters in order, to spell their name or other words. They could also hit letters one at a time to spell out messages to each other.

Open questions: "Name some words with letter ___." "What could we do differently next time.?"
