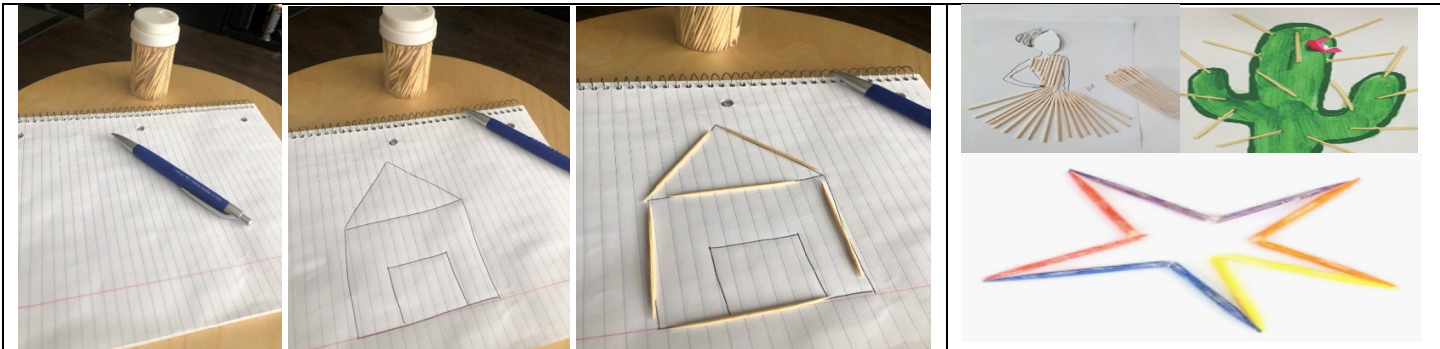


# Title: Toothpick Art

Type of Activity: Art

## Materials:

- Paper
- Marker
- Toothpicks
- Glue

## How to Do it:

- Have your child draw a picture
- Now, help him or her trace the picture with school glue
- Let your child carefully place the toothpicks onto the glue
- You can use a colourful picture & add the toothpicks as accents or coloured toothpicks for pizzazz.

## Root Skill / Extension:

### Physical: 5.3 Fine motor

You can try this activity with other materials to observe the difference between a straight object and one that bends, for example, yarn or string.

**Extend the learning:** Your child can build a 3D model of their 2D toothpick picture, by using stale, mini marshmallows to connect the toothpicks together (Cognitive: 4.17).
