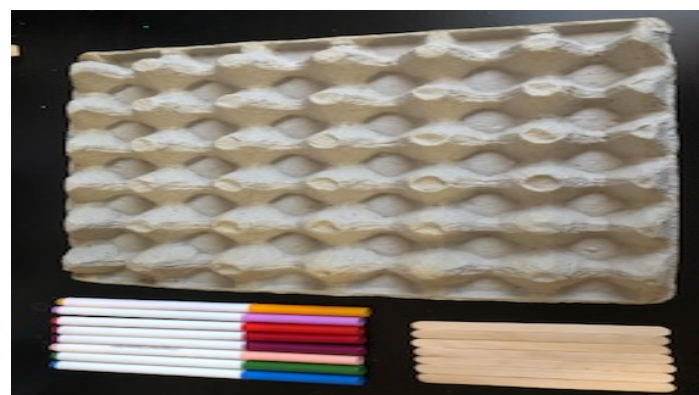


# Title: Popsicle Stick Colour Sorting

Age Group: Toddler

Type of Activity: Fine Motor/Cognitive

## Materials:

- Popsicle Sticks
- Egg Carton (Small or Large)
- Markers or Paint
- Knife

## How to Do it:

- Paint or colour 6 to 8 popsicle sticks
- Colour sections of the egg carton to match the popsicle sticks
- Using a knife, cut a slit in individual egg carton sections
- Have your toddler pick up the coloured popsicle sticks and push them into the matching egg carton slits

## Root Skill / Extension:

**Physical: 5.2 Fine Motor, pincer grasp & Cognitive: 4.9 Colour sorting**

This activity will improve your toddler's hand-eye coordination and fine motor skills.

**Extend the learning:** To increase the challenge, add materials like coloured rice, pasta, pompoms or cotton balls to drop into painted paper towel rolls taped to the wall. Try other colour sorting activities like beading fruit loops on coloured pipe cleaners, a scavenger hunt for coloured objects around the house, or I-Spy sensory bottles using rice and small coloured toys.
