



Donlands Avenue and Strathmore Boulevard Easier Access preliminary work: water main relocation

Timeline: Starting as early as November 23, 2020

What we are doing and why:

As part of the TTC's commitment to safety and modernization, Donlands Station (Line 2) will be getting new elevators to provide accessibility, and a second entrance/exit to improve customer safety and convenience.

To minimize the duration of overall construction, the TTC will build the Donlands Station Easier Access project at the same time as the second exit/entrance project. We would like to provide you with an update regarding upcoming construction activities in your neighbourhood.

Easier Access preliminary works - water main relocation:

As early as Monday, November 23, 2020 (for approximately three weeks) crews on behalf of the TTC will be working to relocate a watermain along Donlands Avenue roadway (near the TTC station) in preparation for the upcoming Easier Access/elevator construction work.

Work hours and noise:

The work is planned to occur Monday to Friday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. and will include: cutting of asphalt, excavation, watermain relocation and replacement of the removed asphalt. Noise and vibration associated with construction can be expected with this work. The contractor will work to keep both to a minimum.

Traffic lane restrictions:

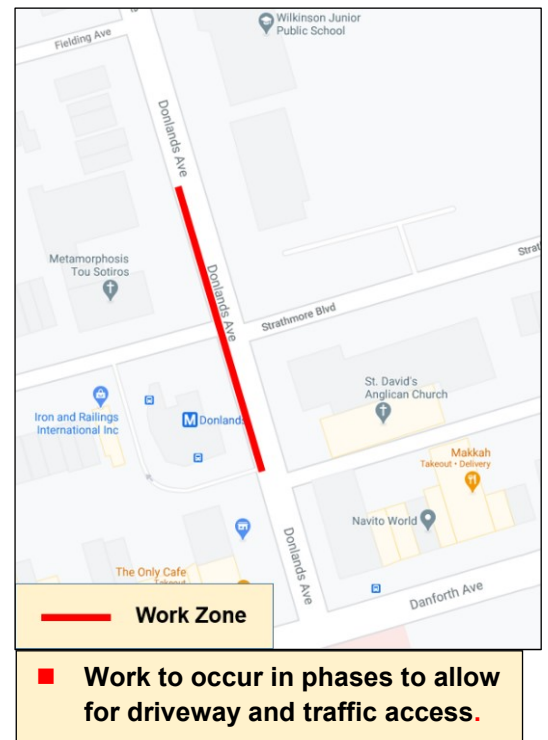
- Traffic will be reduced to one lane on Donlands Avenue in the southbound direction through the work zone area indicated in red (in the adjacent image) for the duration of the work.
- The location of the work zone may inhibit left and right turns.
- The lane reductions and work zone will be restored once Donlands Avenue has been rehabilitated for road traffic. Steel plates will be installed upon completion of this work.

Pedestrian Impact

- Pedestrian traffic **will not** be impacted by this work.

TTC service:

- **Transit will not be impacted by this construction work.** Staff will be present to assist buses exiting the Donlands Station bus loop in the event it is required.
