



Donlands Station: Dewatering activities begin October 6 Street parking removed from Strathmore Boulevard

Timeline: October 6, 2021 to late 2022

*Content / timeline accurate at time of printing and work is weather dependent

Beginning this week, as early as Wednesday, October 6, a dewatering tank will be placed on Strathmore Blvd as part of the next construction phase for the future elevators at Donlands Station. The dewatering tank location is in front of 31 – 33 Strathmore Blvd.

Caisson drilling work continues until the end of October at the elevator construction site located at Donlands Station. Dewatering work will require the removal of permit parking from Strathmore Blvd for this work (**see parking for more details**).

What to Expect

Dewatering is the next step in the excavation process for the TTC's elevator construction at Donlands Station. The work involves removing groundwater from the two elevator construction sites at Strathmore Blvd and Donlands Ave on the northwest and southwest sides of the intersection.

- The set-up includes one dewatering tank, a generator and hoses. The hoses from the elevator construction sites discharge water into the catch-basin on Strathmore Blvd.
- **Dewatering activities are expected to continue until late 2022.**
- Noise and vibration are expected from this work during the initial set-up of the dewatering tank. **The work also includes the use of a generator on-site that will emit a low hum.** The contractor is monitoring vibration and noise and complying with City of Toronto Noise and Construction Vibration By-Laws.
- Construction trucks, equipment and site staff, will be present in the general area.

Parking

- On-street parking will be removed on Strathmore Blvd west of Donlands Ave for the dewatering tank and construction equipment.
- Accessible parking stalls on Strathmore Blvd will be maintained.
- Neighbours who had permit parking on Strathmore Blvd from Donlands Ave to Dewhurst Blvd have been provided alternate parking accommodations, from the TTC, in nearby Green P lots.

Timing

- The dewatering work begins on October 6, 2021, and continues until late 2022.
- Construction work is scheduled to take place between 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday. Notification will be provided for overnight or weekend work if required.
- **Crews mobilize on-site at 6:30 a.m. and begin work at 7 a.m.**

Traffic, pedestrian and transit restrictions

- Pedestrian walkways will remain open.
